Registration Policy

- For an author with multiple papers, the discount rate is applicable as follows. The first paper needs to be registered with the full rate, while the subsequent papers in the same registration form may be paid with a 50% discount. However, only one conference passport will be issued to the registered author. For example, Author A and Author B have co-authored two papers, i.e., Paper 1 and Paper 2. The followings are possible registration scenarios with discount (IEEE) rates:
 - Author A or Author B registers both Paper 1 and Paper 2 in one registration form and pays a total of (US \$862.50). Author A or B will receive one conference passport.
 - Author A and Author B registers individually Paper 1 and Paper 2 and pays one registration per paper. Both Authors A and B will receive one conference passport.
- PhD forum papers can be registered in the discount rate of regular registrations (i.e., US \$300).
- Workshop authors can either pay regular conference registration and attend all the workshops and the conference or pay only workshop registration. In the later case they cannot attend the conference sessions or other workshops. If however, a workshop participant later wants to upgrade his/her registration to attend the conference then an additional fee of \$125 must be paid.
- Student registration is valid for full-time students without any presentation activity.

Note: For registration fees paid by credit cards, the actual charges depend on the exchange rates and possible processing fees charged by credit card companies.

- Each paper to be included in the MDM 2010 proceedings (including regular, short, and poster research papers, industry papers, demo and workshop papers) must have at least one regular registration by its authors.
- A workshop participant gets a red tag and a conference participant will get a blue tag. PhD forums will get a red tag but they will not get conference proceedings.
- Authors must register before March 15, 2010 for their papers to be included in the conference proceedings.

4. The student registration rates are valid only for full-time students who can provide a letter from their supervisors.
5. Both regular and student registrations include one reception ticket, one banquet ticket, and coffee breaks.
6. A limited number of tickets for banquet are available for conference accompanies (US \$100 each).

Page Limits and Over Length Charges. The over-length charge must be paid at the time of registration.

Regular (Research)/Industrial Papers: Normal page-limit 10 pages in IEEE format including all figures, tables, and references.

Note: Up to 2 extra pages (over normal page limit of 10) are allowed and may be purchased at US \$100/page.

No extra pages are allowed to the following categories of accepted papers

1. **Short Papers:** Normal page-limit 6 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.
2. **Poster Papers:** Normal page-limit 3 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.
3. **Demo Paper:** Normal page-limit 3 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.
4. **PhD Forum Paper:** Normal page-limit 2 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.
5. **Workshop Regular Papers:** Normal page-limit 6 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.
6. **Workshop Short Papers:** Normal page-limit 3 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.

Cancellation Policy

A 50% cancellation fee will be charged. No refund will be processed for cancellation request submitted after May 15, 2010. Please note that all approved refunds will only be processed after the Conference.
